Bu bilgileri her fırsatta güncelleyeceğiz. Since 15th July 20126, shariatist Turkish President RT Erdogan and the state apparatus working directly under his authority have begun an operation to oppress, terrorize and purge public employees and private citizens. Tens of thousands of state officials have been either suspended, or simply purged, expelled from their positions losing whatever labour rights they had until then including even common civil rights, and got arrested without any charge. The Erdogan regime has issued many decrees starting countless operations against which there are no legal platforms to complain or appeal under the State of Emergency (OHAL) which itself is a regime of lawlessness. Anybody who wants to follow the "official" developments under this regime of oppression and terror under the leadership of RT Erdogan, which have resulted in banning, closing workplaces, confiscating whatever assets they had and the arrest of tens of thousands of people without any charge could look at <http://www.resmigazete.gov.tr/default.aspx#>

KESK, the Confederation of Public Employees' Trade Unions, has organized in April 2017 a "Conference on State Emergency (OHAL) - Government by Decree Regime and Purges", where Mr Lami Ozgen, the President of KESK, said the following:

"No legal procedures are working during the purges and suspendings. Our appeals to administrative tribunals and Council of State (Danıştay) are being rejected on the ground of 'lack of authority'. All judiciary including the Constitutional Court have left the OHAL and decrees to the Government's judgement and executive's initiative. We are faced with developments without any whatsoever judicial control. There are 103,000 public employees who have been purged / dismissed from their jobs indefinitely under these circumstances. 3,100 of these are members of KESK unions. Moreover, 698 of our colleagues have been suspended. (...) These purges aim to destroy our right to work and job security as well as our demand for democratic, scientific, secular education also in mother tongue and demand for the autonomous university. Expulsions have also physically removed our right to social security, health and free travel. It is the union rights and the freedom to organise which have been threatened and penalised. Also, the fact that 330 of those purged are our unions' leaders exposes this aspect of the developments as well."
